Flyweight Division August 11, 2015

I. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

On July 29, 2015, WBA #6 Stamp Kiatniwat defeated #7 Gregorio Lebron via majority decision after 12 rounds in a close and controversial decision for the WBA's vacant interim title. The bout was scored 113-113, 112-116, and 109-117. Thereafter, in light of the close and controversial nature of the decision, a direct rematch was requested.

II. <u>DECISION</u>

- 1. Pursuant to WBA Rule C.26, the WBA reviewed the scoring and decision on a round by round basis, and has determined that the scoring and bout as a whole was sufficiently close to warrant an immediate rematch.
- 2. The parties have thirty (30) days to negotiate the terms of said rematch. If a purse bid is necessary, the split will be 75% to the Champion, Kiatniwat, and 25% to the Challenger, Lebron. In the meantime, neither boxer may participate in any other bout until after the rematch occurs.
