I. ANALYSIS

The current heavyweight champion situation has raised concern and caused some confusion, besides it is the only weight division in which the full impact of the WBA's resolutions on reducing and eliminating various titles has not been carried to fruition.

Rule C.29 provides that there should be a Mandatory contender for each weight division who should be selected by the Championships Committee or through an eliminatory bout, or as Rule C.31 and Rule C.32 state, the Committee may order a "box-off" to name a sole champion of the division.

II. DECISION:

In light of the above, the Committee resolves the following fights are hereby ordered:

Bout A: *Trevor Bryan must fight Daniel Dubois in no later than 180 days, from March 3rd, 2022.*

Bout B: *Robert Helenius must fight Hughie Fury in no later than 180 days, from March 3rd, 2022.*

Bout C: *Winner of Bout_A must fight Winner of Bout_B in a time frame up to 180 days from the date of the latter bouts mentioned in the above paragraphs.*

III. CONDITIONS:

Please be advised that the following conditions will be in effect:

- a. The parties will have sixty (60) days to negotiate. If no agreement is reached, the committee will call a purse bid.*
- b. If a boxer declines to participate in the Box Off he may be demoted, or removed from the rankings.*
- c. There will be no extensions or special considerations.*

This letter supersedes any previous resolution.
